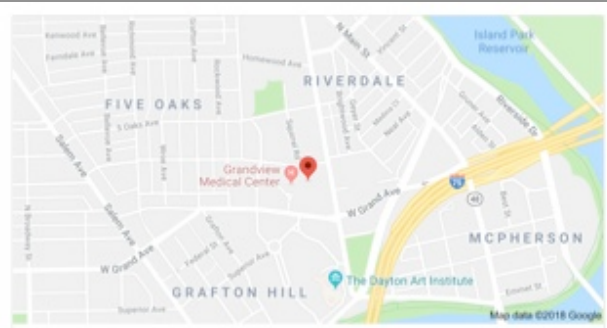

WHAT IS THE ACADEMY MEMORIAL FUND?

The Academy Memorial Fund, which started as a 501-C3 (federal qualifying organization) was established in the early 1980's and was originally developed to provide potential "no interest" loans to 3rd and 4th year Osteopathic medical students. As the federal government began offering larger student loans, the Executive Council members repurposed the fund account to a more philanthropic purpose.

Today those medical professionals looking for monetary assistance to offset educational expenses, could be eligible for full or partial funding thru the Academy Memorial Fund. Applicants could be eligible for up to \$500 of funds thru the Academy Memorial Fund.

In this way, the Dayton District Academy of Osteopathic Medicine - Academy Memorial Fund will strengthen the Osteopathic profession by promoting comprehensive Osteopathic training, resources, and other Osteopathic learning opportunities to improve the health of patients, communities, and the populations that Osteopathic physicians serve.
